



Body measurement instructions

You are going to take your body measurements, required for the construction of your corset.

If you don't feel comfortable dealing with it, somebody around you may help you, alternatively, you can ask a fitter to do it for you.

To proceed, you must be dressed with **underwear only**.

To start with, tie a ribbon around your natural waistline.

This will help you to take some measurements.

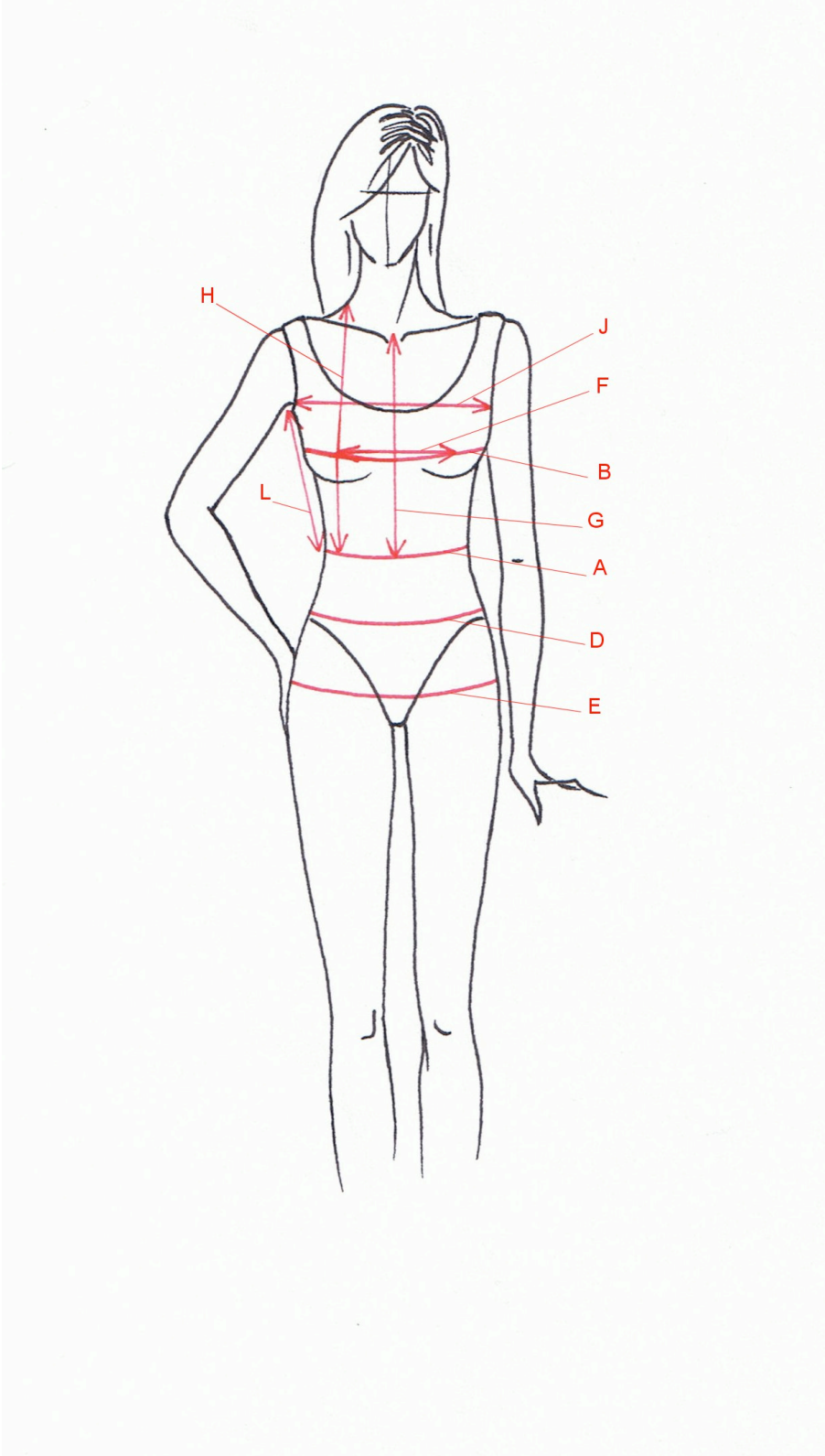
All measurements must be taken without tightening the tape measure.

A	Waist	Narrower area of the waist
B	Bust	Over nipples, around body (the tape measure must be straight in the back)
C	Under-bust	Just under breasts (the tape measure must be straight in the back)
D	Upper hips	10 cm below waist line.
E	Lower hips	20cm below waist line (larger part around the body)
F	Breast space	Nipple to nipple
G	Front length	From neck base to waist
H	Bust height (in 2 measures)	From base of the neck, at shoulder's level, through nipple (1st measurement), then keeping the nipple point straight to waist (2nd measure)
I	Neckline	From waist to the neck line you wish (centre front of the corset)
J	Front width	From arm pit to arm pit (arms along body)
K	Back width	From arm pit to opposite arm pit (arms along body)
L	Side length	Under arm (arm along the body) to waist
M	Bra	Bra size and cup
